Godparents are required to provide verification of Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation.



## REQUIREMENTS FOR GODPARENTS AND CONFIRMATION SPONSORS

Only those practicing Catholics who are registered in our Church, attend Mass every Sunday and all holydays, who have received Communion and Confirmation (not necessarily at Assumption Church) and if married, you have to be married in the Catholic Church, are eligible to act at Godparents at a Baptism and/or Sponsors for Confirmation.

## The Archdiocese of Newark Reports all Allegations of Abuse -

The Archdiocese of Newark takes all complaints of sexual misconduct by members of the clergy, Religious, and lay staff of the Archdiocese very seriously.

We encourage anyone with any knowledge of an act of sexual misconduct to inform the Archdiocese immediately so that we can take the appropriate action and provide support to the victim. Although the Archdiocese immediately reports all abuse allegations to the appropriate County Prosecutor, it also encourages victims to independently report such matters to the Prosecutor.

Individuals who want to report an allegation of sexual misconduct to the Archdiocese may do so by calling the Victim's Assistance Coordinator of the Archdiocesan Office of Child and Youth Protection at 201-407-3256.
